TIPS FOR THE RECITAL

- 1 **Names on Everything.** With everyone having identical costumes and Carlson's Gear clothing, mix-ups and lost items are inevitable. Please make sure your child's name is on all recital costumes and Carlson's Wear.
- 2 Be sure to **collect all costume pieces** to take away at the end of each rehearsal and recital.
- 3 Safety pins, needles & thread, scotch tape, extra bobby pins, elastics, etc can save many situations from stress.
- 4 The doors of the Dressing Room open at least 30 minutes before the start time of the Rehearsals and Recitals.
- 5 The **name of your child's dance** is useful when picking up pictures, buying tickets for the right show, etc. Do you know what it is?
- 6 The **Finale** will be practised during the rehearsals at 6:00 p.m. just before the 15 min. break.

BUY TICKETS EARLY

Tickets for the Recitals are now on sale at the Cowichan Ticket Centre (Adults-\$11.00, Seniors/Students-\$9.00, Children under 12-\$7.00). Please buy your tickets before the day of the Recital. The Ticket Centre Staff will no longer offer a choice of seats just before the show starts. In this way, they avoid people holding up the line while choosing tickets.
